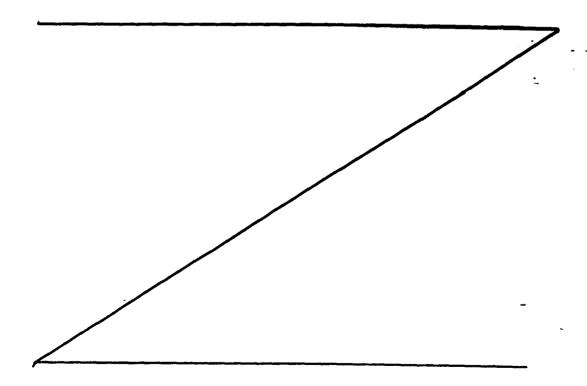

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 8 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0800 AND ADDING SECTIONS 101.0801 THROUGH 101.0821 RELATING TO OFF-STREET PARKING.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 8 of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended, by amending Section 101.0800 and adding Sections 101.0801 through 101.0821 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0813 MINIMUM DIMENSIONS FOR PARKING SPACES

- A. Parking spaces shall have a minimum width of eight and one-half (8-1/2) feet and a minimum depth of twenty (20) feet, except for spaces for less than standard size cars as authorized by this section, which shall have a minimum width of seven and one-half (7-1/2) feet and a minimum depth of fifteen (15) feet.
- B. Commencing on the effective date of the ordinance adopting these regulations, 40 percent of the total minimum off~street parking requirement may be allocated to compact car spaces; commencing January 1, 1981, this allocation may be increased to 50 percent; and, commencing January 1, 1983, this allocation may be increased to 60 percent.
- C. Compact car spaces shall be clearly designated and all necessary markings and signs shall be maintained and/or replaced on a regular interval as may be necessary. When existing parking areas are redesigned to accommodate compact car spaces, the old signs and space markings shall be removed or completely covered in an appropriate manner as approved by the Zoning Administrator.

D. Aisles and driveways shall be dimensioned in substantial conformance with standards adopted by the Planning Commission as set forth in a document entitled "Locational Criteria, Developmental Standards and Operational Standards - Off-street Parking Lots," on file in the office of the Planning Department. Substantial conformance shall be determined by the Zoning Administrator; said determination shall be subject to appeal in the manner set forth in Section 101.0504.

SEC. 101.0814 ACCESS AND GRADES

- A. Each space shall open directly upon an aisle or driveway of such width and design as to provide safe and efficient means of vehicular access to such parking space, except as herein provided. All required parking facilities shall have convenient, direct and adjacent access to a public street or alley.
- B. The Zoning Administrator may approve a minimum driveway width of not less than 10 feet for single- and two-family residential uses and of not less than 12 feet for multiple-family residential uses, provided the average driveway slope does not exceed eight percent and provided there will not be an unsafe condition created. In all other cases, the City Traffic Engineer shall recommend the minimum driveway widths.

C. The maximum grade in any direction within a parking area shall be six percent, except that where unusual or special circumstances warrant, the Zoning Administrator may approve grades recommended by the City Traffic Engineer.

- A. In the single-family residential zones, tandem parking shall be permitted; provided, however, that said parking shall not be permitted to be placed within a required front or street side yard, there shall be compliance with all other regulations pertaining to the single-family zones, and all parking spaces shall be a minimum width of eight and one-half feet and a minimum depth of 20 feet if tandem parking is utilized.
- B. In the multi-family residential zones, tandem parking shall be permitted; provided, however, that for any premises utilizing tandem parking the minimum parking requirement shall be two parking spaces for each dwelling unit. It shall be further provided:
 - That tandem parking shall be provided to a depth of not more than two spaces;
 - That tandem parking shall not be permitted in required front or street side yards;

3. That, notwithstanding the provisions of SEC. 101.0813 (MINIMUM DIMENSIONS FOR PARKING SPACES), all tandem spaces (two spaces) shall have a minimum width of eight and one-half feet and a minimum depth of 35 feet; and

4. That tandem parking, whenever utilized, shall be assigned and enforced by the owner (or the assigned representative of the owner) of the premises.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

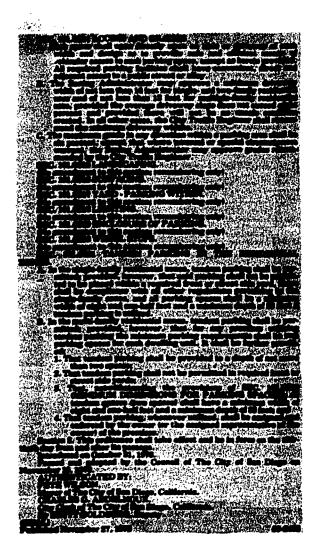
