BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, 7 1978 pursuant to California Public Resources Code, Section 21081, the following findings are made with respect to the environmental facts identified in the Sixth Amendment to Environmental Impact Report No. 75-06-21P:

The Environmental Quality Division, in the sixth amendment to Environmental Impact Report EQD No. 75-06-21, has reviewed the proposed project and determined that:

". . . the findings of the original Environmental Impact Report remain generally accurate and sufficient; however, originally identified noise, geology and land use impacts would not apply to the subject property. A single remaining significant environmental effect involves the overall development's contribution to cumulative increases in air pollutant generation. Within the scope of the project there is no feasible mitigation which would significantly alter the nature or magnitude of this impact.
