As you can see from the enclosed brochure, our services have grown considerably in the past two years. We now feel most desires of the San Diego visitor are accommodated by our program. It is now, however, time to expand.

I'm delighted to inform you that we are applying to the Public Utilities Commission, State of California, for authority to conduct daily service to Disneyland/Lion Country Safari from here and to pick up people in Orange County and bring them to the zoo or Sea World.
