BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that pursuant to California Public Resources Code, Section 21081, the following findings are made with respect to the environmental impacts identified in Environmental Impact Report No. 77-03-36:

Established noise data based on present and future operational plans have been considered. Although unique helicopter criteria does not exist, two accepted criteria have been utilized and, by either, the development site is acceptable for residential use. Further, as CNEL is the accepted environmental noise criteria for the development of all other areas within the City of San Diego adjacent to airports, consistency of policy dictates that the proposed development is in an acceptable noise area.

Even though the City's criterion and the Navy's criteria for residential development have not been exceeded at the Sunrise Addition site, there still may be a desire to lessen noise further. This can be accomplished in two general ways. Additional reduction in noise will be accomplished by using noise insulation techniques similar to those required in multifamily dwellings.
