WHEREAS, in 1973 and 1976, the City Council passed Resolution Nos. 209041, 209042 and 217234 whereby the Council recognized the need for an additional border crossing on Otay Mesa at the point easterly of Brown Field and the Tijuana Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City Council continues to recognize the need for and supports an additional border crossing on Otay Mesa; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs with the tentative decision of the Governor of the State of Baja California of the Republic of Mexico and the San Diego County Board of Supervisors that the Harvest Road area of Otay Mesa is a preferred location for a second border crossing; and

WHEREAS, the California Highway Commission, the California Department of Transportation and the United States Government has recognized the fact that access roads are essential to the effective functioning of border crossing gates and in view of the international character of the border crossing, the construction of such access roads should be entitled to state and/or federal funding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$30,000 within Gas Tax Reserve Fund to CIP 52-140 and that expenditure of said



funds is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of advancing the preliminary design phase of Otay Mesa Road from the FY-1979 budget to the FY-1978 budget.
