Sentencing Act of 1976 (Stats. 1976, Chapt. 1139) does not have

effective provisions to protect the public from criminals who

commit violent crimes and in fact such law encourages their

early release; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 709 (Presley) has been introduced to increase the penalties for criminals committing violent crimes thus adding needed protection for society; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the Department of Legislative Representation is hereby directed to take all necessary action, for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, to declare the City's support for Senate Bill No. 709, introduced by Senator Presley, or any similar legislation which would increase the present penalties for convicted criminals who have committed violent crimes.
