RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FINDING AND
DETERMINING THAT PUBLIC CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY REQUIRE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS.

(Beyer Boulevard, Dairy Mart Road to I-805, Assessment District)

WHEREAS, in proceedings under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000, Streets and Highways Code), the Council adopted resolution of intention, Resolution No. 220289, ordering the Superintendent of Streets to prepare the Report required by that Act and pursuant thereto the Superintendent of Streets prepared the Report, consisting of plans and specifications describing the proposed improvements, an estimate of the costs and expenses thereof, a diagram showing the assessment district, and a proposed assessment of such costs and expenses, the Report being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. 220290 approved the Report, as filed, and appointed a time and place of hearing thereon and also for a public hearing on the question of whether public convenience and necessity require such improvements and whether the Special Assessment

WHEREAS, at the hearings all persons desiring to be heard were fully heard and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, were fully heard and this Council gave all persons present an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to the Report, the diagram and assessment, the proposed acquisitions and improvements, the boundaries of the proposed assessment district, the serial bonds to be issued to represent unpaid assessments, the question of whether public convenience and necessity require such improvements, whether the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and the debt limitation and majority protest provisions thereof shall apply, or in any way relating to the Report and the proceedings proposed by the resolution of intention; and
