RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING  
CHANGES IN THE REPORT, ASSESSMENT,  
AND CITY CONTRIBUTION

MAY 6 1978

(Beyer Boulevard, Dairy Mart Road  
to I-805, Assessment District)

WHEREAS, in proceedings under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000, Streets and Highways Code) the Council adopted resolution of intention, Resolution No. 220289, ordering the Superintendent of Streets to prepare the Report required by said Act and, pursuant thereto, the Superintendent of Streets has prepared the Report, including the four parts submitted with and made a part of the Report, said parts consisting of plans and specifications describing the proposed acquisitions and improvements, a proposed diagram showing the assessment district and a proposed assessment of the costs and expenses of the proposed acquisitions and improvements, the Report being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Resolution No. 220290 approving the Report, as filed, and appointing a time and place of hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 1978 the Superintendent of Streets submitted a Supplemental Report recommending certain

increases in the amounts of the individual and total assessments and in the city contribution, all as more particularly described therein, and the Council adopted Resolution No. 220614 proposing and declaring its intention to make the changes described in the Supplemental Report and fixing a hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 220614 was duly published and copies thereof were duly mailed to all persons whose assessments were proposed to be increased and the hearing on the proposed changes was duly held; and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that the city contribution should be increased to an amount greater than that shown in the Supplemental Report and the amounts of the total and all individual assessments should be decreased from those shown on the Supplemental Report and the Superintendent of Streets has prepared and submitted a "Schedule of Changes" showing and describing all such changes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The "Schedule of Changes" of the Superintendent of Streets, attached hereto and made a part

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hereof, is approved and those parts of the original Report referred to in the schedule shall be and are hereby ordered to be changed in the manner and as more particularly shown and described in the schedule. The Superintendent of Streets is authorized and directed to change the original Report, as filed with the City Clerk, in conformance therewith.

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SCHEDULE OF CHANGES

To The Honorable City Council:

On April 4, 1978, the Superintendent of Streets submitted a Supplemental Report proposing increases in the City contribution, the total assessment, and all individual assessments. The Council approved the Supplemental Report and fixed a hearing on the proposed increases.

If the City further increases its proposed contribution (as indicated in the revised estimate, Part II hereof), decreases may be made in the amounts of the total assessment and all individual assessments (as set forth in said Supplemental Report), in which case the final amounts will be as shown in Part IV hereof.

Upon approval by the Council of this Schedule of Changes, the hereinafter described changes shall be made in the original report heretofore submitted to the Council. References made herein to "Parts" refer to the corresponding parts of the original report. The changes are as follows:

Part II. The estimate of the cost of the improvement and incidental expenses is changed as follows:
