A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE PARK BOULEVARD (UPAS STREET TO UNIVERSITY AVENUE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. _____ 220813 , a public hearing was called for on ______ IIN 13 1978 _____ at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

The westerly 75 feet of Lots 1 through 5 BLOCK 249 and Lots 30 and 31 BLOCK 248 UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS MAP 526; the southerly 110 feet of the easterly 200 feet of Pueblo Lot 1125 bordering Robinson Avenue and Park Boulevard.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

PARK BOULEVARD between the southerly line of Upas Street and the southerly line of University Avenue, FRONTAGE ROAD (at University Avenue) between the easterly line of Park Boulevard and a line parallel to and 75 feet east of said easterly line, ROBINSON AVENUE between a line parallel to and 200 feet west of the westerly line of Park Boulevard and a line parallel to and 30 feet east of the easterly line of Indiana Street, INDIANA STREET between the southerly line of Robinson Avenue and a line parallel to and 100 feet south of said southerly line, PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE between the westerly line of Park Boulevard and a line parallel to and 20 feet west of said westerly line, CYPRESS AVENUE between the westerly line of Park Boulevard and a line parallel to and 50 feet west of said westerly line, BROOKES AVENUE between

the westerly line of Park Boulevard and a line parallel to and 20 feet west of said westerly line, MYRTLE AVENUE between the westerly line of Park Boulevard and a line parallel to and 20 feet west of said westerly line, UPAS STREET between the westerly line of Park Boulevard and a line parallel to and 20 feet west of said westerly line;

and all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17802-D entitled "PARK BOULEVARD (Upas Street to University Avenue) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. '763507 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be

JUN 1 3 1978 60732 an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State MICROFILMED




