WHEREAS, The City of San Diego and County of San Diego are desirous to jointly establishing the Lake Murray/Cowles/
Fortuna Mountain Regional Park for the benefit of all citizens and visitors of the City and County of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Reynolds Environmental Group, a private consultant, has prepared a report entitled, "Master Development Plan Report for Lake Murray/Cowles/Fortuna Mountain Regional Park"; and

WHEREAS, said Master Development Plan Report for Lake Murray/Cowles/Fortuna Mountain Regional Park recommends tentative boundaries for a regional park; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the regional park's boundaries will be helpful for planning of the park; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Diego have jointly formed the Lake Murray/Cowles/Fortuna Mountain Regional Park Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the City-County Task Force has recommended that the City and County adopt the park's tentative boundaries as recommended in the Master Development Plan Report for the regional park in order to facilitate planning; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the conceptual boundaries for Lake Murray/Cowles/
 Fortuna Mountain Regional Park shall be, for planning purposes
 only, those depicted in the Master Development Plan Report for
 Lake Murray/Cowles and Fortuna Mountain dated July 1976, as
 amended by Paragraph 2 herein; provided, however, that City
 staff may from time to time alter the proposed boundaries and
 park area; provided that approval of said boundaries shall be
 subject to all procedures necessary for amending the appropriate
 community plans and the General Plan; and provided that such
 recognition of said boundaries is not intended to constitute an
 announcement of The City of San Diego's intent to acquire by
 purchase or condemnation any particular parcel of property
 located within said boundaries; but rather is intended to
 facilitate continued planning for potential future park development.
- 2. That the proposed boundaries shall exclude all Navy land north of the proposed "Q" alignment of Highway 52; the KFMB's transmission facilities' site; and the property owned by Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Gagliano (Assessors Parcel #386-320-090), from the boundaries of the park.
- 3. That any parcels within the conceptual boundaries of the proposed park which are ultimately excluded from the park and utilized for private purposes will be developed in a manner consistent with and sympathetic to the adjacent park use.
- 4. That any action regarding the conceptual boundaries of the proposed park does not exclude the consideration of the continued use and potential exclusion from the park of areas

currently within the park which are being utilized for electronic transmitting and receiving facilities.

- 5. That City staff is directed to develop with the staff of the County of San Diego, subject to Board and Council approval, an agreement providing for the possible implementation of the plan for the above identified regional park including if necessary the preparation of any environmental documentation.
- 6. That staff is directed to include in the proposed budgets for Council consideration for each of the next five fiscal years adequate funds to cover the City's proposed implementation plan.
