RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT ASSESS-MENTS FOR THE SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1978 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1979.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego proposes and intends to levy and collect assessments necessary to provide energy, maintenance and incidental costs required to operate street lights within the SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHT MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1, for the period July 1, 1978 through June 30, 1979, under the provisions of the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975, authorized by Article XIII, Section 17 of the California Constitution and provided for in Section 65.0201 through 65.0220 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no new areas are proposed to be annexed to or dissolved from the district established by Resolution No. 210944, adopted July 1, 1974, but that the maps showing the parcels to be assessed shall be amended at the time of the hearing to provide for certain recent lot consolidations and lot splits, and annual changes in certain individual lights.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed maintenance includes the supplying of energy to street lights, replacing lamps and other glassware, and the periodic cleaning and painting of standards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council does further propose, in connection with the aforesaid maintenance district proceedings, to enter into new contracts with the San Diego Gas & Electric Co. for the furnishing of electrical energy and switching for the period of July 1, 1978 through June 30, 1979. Said contracts will make provision for the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 and the form of said contracts are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. 1763927 and 1763928 August 1, 1978

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice is hereby given that on __at 2:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, The Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in the City of San Diego, California, is the day, hour and place for the hearing when any person interested may object to the proposed maintenance for the aforesaid territory, the amount of the assessment, or the awarding of the contract. Failure to make objection at that time shall be deemed to be a waiver of all objections and shall operate as a bar for any claim for damages.

Such protest, if any, must be in writing and must contain a description of the property in which each signer thereof is interested, sufficient to identify the same, and shall be delivered to and filed with the City Clerk at a time no later than the hour set for the hearing. No other protests shall be considered.
