

RESOLUTION NO. 221583

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTION AND THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 6, 1978 ON ONE BOND MEASURE RELATING TO BONDS OF OPEN SPACE PARK FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1; ONE BOND MEASURE RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION OF POLICE FACILITIES AND ONE PROPOSITION TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER.

WHEREAS, this Council by Ordinances Nos. 12321 and 12322 (New Series) adopted March 21, 1978, called a special municipal bond election and a special municipal election to be held in the City on June 6, 1978; and

WHEREAS, these special municipal elections were duly consolidated with the statewide primary election held upon the same date; and

WHEREAS, the special municipal bond election and the special municipal election were held on June 6, 1978, for the purpose of proposing and submitting to the qualified electors of the City three propositions as follows:

PROPOSITION C:

PROPOSITION C.

Shall the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1 incur an indebtedness, to be represented by general obligation bonds of the District, in the maximum principal amount of Sixty Five Million Dollars (\$65,000,000), to provide funds for the acquisition of open space and other park facilities, as more particularly described in the San Diego Park Facilities District Procedural Ordinance?

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PROPOSITION D:

PROPOSITION D. CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENT. AMENDS SECTION 143 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

Requires actuarial tables for retirement allowances to be approved by the City Council rather than the Board of Administration of the Retirement System.

PROPOSITION E:

PROPOSITION E. CITY OF SAN DIEGO POLICE FACILITIES BOND PROPOSAL.

For the purposes of implementing a modernization and decentralization program to better service the law enforcement and public safety needs of the citizens of San Diego, shall the City of San Diego incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of twenty-two million two hundred thousand dollars (\$22,200,000.00) to permit the acquisition, construction or completion of public improvements and facilities for the use by the Police Department?

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassing the returns of the special municipal bond election and the special municipal election, including absentee votes cast, as certified to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the special municipal bond election and the special municipal election has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

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BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code as follows:

1. The total number of votes cast in the City, including absentee votes, is 255,382.

2. The number of votes, including absentee votes, cast for and against each of the three propositions lettered C, D, and E and the total number of votes cast upon each proposition, including absentee votes, are as follows:

PROPOSITION C:

PROPOSITION D:

For	86,082

PROPOSITION E:

3. Proposition C received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters voting on said proposition and is hereby declared to have been approved. Proposition D did not receive the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters voting on said proposition and is hereby declared to have failed. Proposition E did not receive the

affirmative vote of a two-thirds' majority of the qualified voters voting on said proposition and is hereby declared to have failed.

4. The number of votes cast, including absentee votes, is recorded in the Election Returns Book, which book is a part of the records of this Council.

5. The City Clerk shall make public the results of the canvass of the special municipal bond election and the special municipal election by publication of a copy of this resolution.

2. The number of votes, including absentee votes, cast for and against  
each of the three propositions lettered C, D, and E and the total number of  
votes cast upon each proposition, including absentee votes, are as follows:
