WHEREAS, U. S. Senator Alan Cranston has by letter and public statements urged the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") to revise its proposed regulations on ocean discharges to permit waivers from secondary sewage treatment on a caseby-case basis as Congress intended; and

WHEREAS, Senator Cranston's efforts in this regard may assist this City and other ocean dischargers to obtain waivers and save the expenditure of substantial sums of money without any appreciable environmental benefit; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

The City Council of this City does hereby express the appreciation of the City for Senator Cranston's efforts to persuade the EPA to modify its proposed regulations so that the waiver from secondary sewage treatment may be obtained by this City and other eligible coastal cities.
