## LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES PROPOSED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the voters of the State of California on June 6, 1978 overwhelmingly approved Proposition 13, the Jarvis-Gann tax limitation tax initiative; and

WHEREAS, the thrust of Proposition 13 only provided for a cut in the property taxes, therefore curtailing government spending only at the local level; and

WHEREAS, the State Treasury continues to show a substantial surplus each year due in part to the collection of a 6% State Sales and Use Tax; and

WHEREAS, the cities will now, even more than ever, find themselves with a shortage of general fund revenues; and

WHEREAS, the State continues to mandate costs upon the cities without appropriate legal reimbursements; and

WHEREAS, the State has shown some inclination to share the State's surplus with cities, but only after "strings" are attached to the receiving of the money which further erode the "Home Rule Doctrine"; and

WHEREAS, it was the voters' intent by the passage of Proposition 13 to curtail government spending at all levels of government without a loss of important services such as police, fire and sanitation; NOW, THEREFORE,

## LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES PROPOSED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the passage of Proposition 13 at the June 6, 1978 Statewide Election has created uncertainties in the use of taxincrement bonds for financing redevelopment projects; and

WHEREAS, a substantial number of outstanding tax-increment financed bond issues are in jeopardy of either technical or actual default; and

WHEREAS, the State has taken preliminary steps to provide assistance to redevelopment agencies which have outstanding taxincrement financed bonds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the General Assembly of the League of California Cities assembled in Annual Conference in Anaheim, California, September 27, 1978 that the League urges the State Treasurer's office to work with the League's technical drafting committee to provide at the earliest possible date establishment of criteria for loans to redevelopment agencies which need assistance to avoid either technical or actual defaults which may occur to outstanding tax-increment financed bonds.
