RESOLUTION NO. 221647

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON NOVEMBER 7, 1978, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, the Council has indicated its intention to submit to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego certain propositions relating to Pueblo Lands and amending the Charter of The City of San Diego at a special municipal election to be held in the City on November 7, 1978; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on the same date and that within the City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and that this special municipal election and the statewide general election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has or will adopt an ordinance calling for a special municipal election and consolidating it with the statewide general election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

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- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on November 7, 1978 with the statewide general election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of ratifying the sale or conveyance of certain Pueblo Lands and amending the Charter of The City of San Diego.
- 2. The exact forms of the propositions to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as they are to appear on the ballot are as follows:

- 3. The Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide general election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.

- 5. The City of San Diego hereby agrees to reimburse the County of San Diego in full for the services performed pursuant to this resolution upon presentation of a bill therefor.
- 6. The City of San Diego further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County of San Diego, its officers, agents and employees from expense or liability, including reasonable attorneys fees, as the result of an election contest arising after conduct of the election.
- 7. The City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
