- That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing data processing or law enforcement expenditures or operations.
- That the City Manager is hereby authorized, according to all legal requirements, to negotiate and execute agreements for contractual services that are within the scope of the grant contract on file in the Office of the City Clerk as 764216 and the City Manager shall Document No. periodically report to Council on the progress of the grant project.
