WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Estevan R. Limon, Jr.	General Services	\$ 35	Mr. Limon is an Apprentice II in the Communications and Electrical Division. He suggested that Walkie Talkies be used at Mt. Hope Cemetery during Memorial Day functions rather than sound powered phones. This saves \$339 annually in set-up costs.
Robert W. Snowden	General Services	\$ 35	Mr. Snowden is a Supervising Sanitation Inspector in the Solid Waste Division. He suggested that a rubber stamp be used to resend U.S. Mail erroneously returned to the City. This is expected to save \$1,265 a year. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Thomas B. Wells	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. Wells is a Carpenter in the Buildings Division. He suggested that partition brackets be fabricated in the Equipment Division to be used on replaced rest room partitions. This is expected to extend the life of partition installations.
D. Gary Lee	Fire	\$ 25	Mr. Lee is a Fire Fighter. He suggested a new method of placing a ladder in service by one person. This is a significant safety improvement.
Lucy H. Galvin	City Council	\$ 25	Ms. Galvin is an Administrative Intern in the First District. She suggested that the hole size for three-ring binders be increased. This has been increased from 1/4 to 11/32 of an inch. Savings are difficult to estimate.
