A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING March 9, 1979 AS THE DATE UPON WHICH ALL PROPERTY IN THE KETTNER BOULEVARD PHASE I (PALM STREET TO LAUREL STREET) AND INDIA STREET (MAPLE STREET TO KALMIA STREET) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT MUST BE READY TO RECEIVE UNDERGROUND SERVICE AND JUNE 15, 1979 AS THE DATE FOR THE REMOVAL OF ALL OVERHEAD UTILITY FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, this Council did on April 18, 1978 by Resolution
No. 220683 establish the KETTNER BOULEVARD Phase I (Palm Street
to Laurel Street) and INDIA STREET (Maple Street to Kalmia Street)
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT which required the conversion of
certain overhead electric, communication and community antenna
television facilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Resolution No. 220683 the date upon which property in the district had to be ready to receive underground service and the date upon which the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures had to be effected was to be subsequently designated by resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That March 9, 1979 be and the same is hereby established and designated as the date upon which all property within the KETTNER BOULEVARD Phase I (Palm Street to Laurel Street) and INDIA STREET (Maple Street to Kalmia Street) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT must be ready to receive underground utility service and that June 15, 1979 be and the same is hereby designated as the date upon which all overhead utility facilities must be removed.

- That the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice to all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this Resolution No. within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. City Clerk shall specifically notify the affected persons that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide, at their own expense, all necessary facility changes on their premise so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in
- 3. The City Manager is hereby directed to give notice to such affected persons and affected utilities in accordance with Section 61.0511(b) of the San Diego Municipal Code.
