BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the following Proposed Guidelines for Investment of Retirement System Funds and Surplus City Funds are hereby adopted:

Assuming that the financial considerations of alternative investments are equivalent, the Board of Retirement and the City Treasurer should give preference to those investments which would have the greatest positive impact upon the local economy. Consideration should be given to such factors as job growth, effect on the housing stock and areas of capital deficiency. Such investment preference should not sacrifice the yield, security or fluidity of the portfolio.
