A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY OCT 17 1978 DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE FOURTH AVENUE (BEECH STREET TO LAUREL STREET) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution N	o. 2216 5	8 , a public
hearing was called for on	OCT 31978	_ at the hour of
2:00 p.m., in the Council C	hambers of the Ci	ty Administration
Building, 202 C Street, San D	iego, California,	to determine whether
the public health, safety or	general welfare r	equires the removal
of poles, overhead wires and	associated struct	ures and the under-
ground installation of wires	and facilities fo	r supplying electric,
communication, community ante	nna television or	similar or associated
service within that certain a	rea of the City o	f San Diego more par-
ticularly described as follow	'S:	

Lots A through L in BLOCKS 204, 216, 227, 230, 242, 245, 259 and 262 inclusive, Lots E through H BLOCK 213, Lots C through G BLOCK 281, Lots K and L BLOCK 200, Lot H BLOCK 205, the easterly 50 feet of the following: Lots G through L BLOCK 226, Lots G and J through L BLOCK 241, Lots G through K BLOCK 246, Lots G through K BLOCK 258 and Lots G through K BLOCK 280, all in HORTON'S ADDITION (LOCKLING) DB 13, Page 522.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

FOURTH AVENUE between a line parallel to and 100 feet south of the southerly line of Beech Street and a line parallel to and 100 feet north of the northerly line of Laurel Street, BEECH STREET between a line parallel to and 50 feet west of the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the easterly line of said Avenue, CEDAR STREET between a line parallel to and 100 feet west of the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue, ELM STREET between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue, FIR STREET between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue, GRAPE STREET

between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue, HAWTHORN STREET between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue, IVY STREET between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue, JUNIPER STREET between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue, KALMIA STREET between the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fourth Avenue and the westerly line of Fifth Avenue;

and all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17858-D entitled "FOURTH AVENUE (Beech Street to Laurel Street) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. ______ and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that

pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of

the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.






