RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE BYLAWS OF THE CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation adopted Resolution Number 78-3 on March 17, 1978, which establishes regular meeting days on the first and third Fridays of each month, and

WHEREAS, in addition to the regular meetings held since that time, special meetings of the Corporation have been called as required for the timely consideration and completion of the Corporation's business, and

WHEREAS, under the existing Bylaws for the Corporation the Directors are not being compensated for the additional meetings attended;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Article III, Section 13 of the Corporation's Bylaws are hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 13. Compensation. The Board of Directors may establish directors' fees to be paid to directors attending meetings. The amount of such fee shall not exceed \$50.00 without the written approval of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego. There further shall not be more than four meetings in any calendar month for which a director may receive a director's fee without the written consent of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego. No member or director shall receive any other form of salary or compensation without the approval of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego."
