WHEREAS, the San Diego Metropolitan Transit Development Board ("MTDB") has conducted an extensive analysis of alternative methods of providing transit services within its area of jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, MTDB has prepared and filed with The City of San Diego a Study of Fixed Guideway Transit Alternatives in Centre City San Diego; and

WHEREAS, MTDB, in cooperation with the San Diego Transit Corporation, has prepared and filed with The City of San Diego a Financial Plan for expanded bus/LRT transit services through the year 1995 providing for expanded services without the necessity of additional state or local taxes; and

WHEREAS, MTDB has filed with The City of San Diego a "Memorandum of Intent" duly signed by the Southern Pacific Transportation Company, wherein it is proposed to donate and sell to MTDB the SD&AE Ry., which includes approximately 108 miles of right of way and 2,055 acres of land, together with all operating railroad rights, said railroad right of way to be in a fully restored condition, for the sum of \$18.1 million to be paid by MTDB; and

WHEREAS, the MTDB represents that the light rail concept is in conformity with all adopted regional and local transportation plans; and

WHEREAS, the MTDB light rail concept provides the potential for providing better service to more people at lower cost



than an all bus system; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of The City of San Diego:

- 1. Approves in concept the early implementation of a light rail transit system as proposed by MTDB pursuant to that Financial Plan dated October 18, 1978 and supports the concept of the purchase of the SD&AE Ry. by MTDB which it proposes to consummate on the terms and conditions substantially as set forth in the Memorandum of Intent dated October 20, 1978.
- 2. Approves the alignment for the LRT system in the City of San Diego from the Santa Fe Depot at "C" Street and Kettner Boulevard, east to 12th Avenue, then south along 12th Avenue and the SD&AE right of way to the International Border at San Ysidro.
- 3. Directs City Staff and the City's delegate to the Comprehensive Planning Organization to take all appropriate action as may be necessary to effectuate and carry out the intent of this resolution.
