WHEREAS, the City Manager of The City of San Diego was OCT 3 0 1978 authorized in 1960 to execute a cooperative agreement with the Department of Water Resources, State of California and the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers to prepare a study of beach erosion problems at Point Loma, Pacific Beach and La Jolla in The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers completed their study on beach erosion control in 1963 and found that there was a need for shoreline erosion protection at Sunset Cliffs and in the Bird Rock areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers identified two segments of shoreline for protection in Sunset Cliffs: Segment A - proposed as a sand beach from Santa Cruz Avenue to Osprey Street and Segment B - proposed as rock revetment sections from Osprey Street to Ladera Street; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of The City of San Diego approved a bond proposal in November 1966 for flood control and shore protection works; and

WHEREAS, the final construction of rock revetment for Segment B at Sunset Cliffs was completed in 1973; and

WHEREAS, Sunset Cliffs Segment A protection works have not been constructed primarily because of local opposition to a sand beach; and

WHEREAS, the shoreline erosion north of Osprey Street is a continuing problem; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager in 1974 was authorized to analyze various alternative permanent solutions for the shoreline problems between Osprey Street and Newport Avenue; and

WHEREAS, a City Task Force was formed and produced the study report entitled <u>Sunset Cliffs Newport Avenue to Osprey</u>

<u>Shoreline Protection Study Task Force Report December 1976;</u>
and

WHEREAS, the City Task Force report studied alternative shoreline protection measures and recommended the construction of rock revetment and a program to stabilize the upper cliffs; and

WHEREAS, City Council has taken public testimony and finds that the rock revetment alternative and cliff stabilization program is the preferred method for protecting the shoreline between Osprey Street and Newport Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the development of financial assistance for the project from other agencies may require a substantial time period; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to formulate a preliminary design plan for protecting the shoreline at Sunset Cliffs which can be used as a guide in preparing detail construction designs for: 1) projects sponsored by property owners to provide early protection for portions of the shoreline; and 2) a large major project proposed for State and local participation; NOW, THEREFORE,

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BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That Alternative III-A of the City Task Force Report, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 764984 , which Alternative III-A proposes the construction of approximately 1,500 feet of rock revetment structures in areas needing protection at the base of cliffs between Santa Cruz Avenue and Osprey Street, together with a program to stabilize the upper cliff formation between Newport Avenue and Osprey Street, is hereby approved in concept.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby directed to seek financial assistance for such a project from the State Department of Navigation and Ocean Development and to seek technical assistance from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the preparation of construction plans and specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby directed to develop a preliminary design plan for shoreline protection utilizing rock revetment and an upper cliff stabilization program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the transfer of \$30,000 from the Flood Control and Storm Drain Bond Fund Reserve C.I.P. 90-727 to C.I.P. 13-002 Sunset Cliffs for the procurement of consulting services to provide a preliminary design plan

for Sunset Cliffs in preparation for the development of detail construction plans and specifications is hereby authorized.
