WHEREAS, HENRY R. FLETCHER, agent for JAMES RIEMAN, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in failing to approve Preliminary Parcel Map 78-280, which proposes a two-parcel parcel map of VILLA LOT 19, Mission Hills, Map 1115, located between Allen Road and Sierra Vista and southerly of Altura Place in the R-1-5, R-1-5 HR and R-1-40 HR Zones, and within the boundaries of the Uptown Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 1978, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego voted 3 to 3 on a motion to approve the preliminary parcel map; due to the lack of four votes this is deemed a denial; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, HENRY R. FLETCHER, agent for JAMES RIEMAN, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on November 14, 1978, continued to December 5, 1978, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 102.0308, to affirm, reverse or modify, in whole or in part, any determination of the Planning Commission subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE, 4 MICROFILMED

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- The proposed map is not consistent with the General Plan and Uptown Community Plan which designate the property for residential and open space uses.
- The design and proposed improvements for the subdivision are not consistent with the General Plan and Uptown Community Plan and R-1-5 and R-1-40 Zoning/Development Regulations.
- The site is physically suitable for residential development.
- The site is suitable for the proposed residential density of development.
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage based upon the findings of the Environmental Report EQD No. 78-07-49.
- The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public health problems; however, the map is not consistent with R-1-5 and R-1-40 zoning and does not conform with City Development regulations.
- The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any easements, acquired by the public at large, for access through or use of property within the proposed subdivision.
- That said findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference. 349 OFILMED
