AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12397 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 764187, AS ADOPTED AND AMENDED THEREIN, BY ESTABLISHING THE SAN DIEGO OPEN SPACE PARK FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 ADMINIS-TRATION AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM, BY ADDING THE EQUIVALENT OF TEN (10) STAFF POSITIONS TO THE OPEN SPACE ADMINISTRATION AND MAIN-TENANCE PROGRAM (FUND 10506) FOR THE REMAIN-DER OF THE FISCAL YEAR (BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1979); AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER THE SUM OF \$250,000 FROM THE UNALLOCATED RESERVE TO THE OPEN SPACE ADMINISTRATION AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM: THE GENERAL FUND TO BE REIMBURSED, PRIOR TO THE END OF FISCAL YEAR 1978-79, FROM 1978 OPEN SPACE PARK BOND SALE PROCEEDS.

WHEREAS, the qualified voters of the City of San Diego did, at the Special Municipal Election of June 6, 1978, consider the matter of the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1 incurring an indebtedness, represented by general obligation bonds of the District, for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition of open space and other park facilities (herein called "Proposition C"); and

WHEREAS, Proposition C did receive the required majority vote necessary for approval; and

WHEREAS, implementation of said acquisition program
will require that the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities
District No. 1 establish an Administration and Maintenance
Program and hire ten (10) staff personnel to initiate acquisition, land management, and maintenance activities; and

WHEREAS, the cost to establish this Program and to add ten (10) positions in the current budget for one-half year (beginning January 1, 1979) is estimated to be \$145,497 (the full year program cost is \$289,993); and

WHEREAS, General Funded departments are incurring costs associated with administration of the Open Space Program, and there are certain preliminary acquisition costs; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that these costs (estimated at \$104,503 for the current year) be reimbursed to the General Fund and be available for preliminary acquisition requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 12397 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONIES TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document No. 764187, as adopted and amended therein, by establishing the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1 Administration and Maintenance Program by adding the equivalent of ten (10) staff positions to the Open Space Administration and Maintenance Program (Fund 10506) for the remainder of the fiscal year (beginning January 1, 1979).

Section 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer from

the General Fund Unallocated Reserve to the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1 Administration and Maintenance Program (Fund 10506) the sum of \$250,000 (\$105,056 to Salaries and Wages; \$144,944 to Non-Personal, Equipment Outlay, and Other Expense), the General Fund to be reimbursed prior to the end of Fiscal Year 1978-79, from 1978 Open Space Park Bond sale proceeds.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its adoption.
