AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 7  
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING  
SECTION 67.22 RELATING TO REGULATION OF WATER  
SYSTEM--METER TESTING.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego  
Municipal Code be amended by amending the following section to  
read as follows:

SEC. 67.22 REGULATION OF WATER SYSTEM--METER TESTING

When the accuracy of a water meter is questioned, the  
Department shall, upon the request form provided, cause  
an official test to be made upon deposit by the consumer.  
A schedule of fees shall be established by the City Manager  
and filed in the office of the City Clerk.

If, upon examination of the meter to ascertain the  
accuracy of its operation, it shall be found to register  
over 3% more water than actually passes through it, another  
meter will be substituted therefor, and the fee charged for  
such test will be refunded to the person making the appli-  
cation. An adjustment for a period of three months prior  
to the test will be made on the basis of the percentage the  
meter is in error.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force  
on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
