AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 18, SECTIONS 62.0110 AND 62.0111 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO DELETE REFERENCE TO CONTRACT TO CLARIFY THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL PERSONS PERFORMING WORK PURSUANT TO SECTION 62.0101 MUST BE BONDED.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the first sentence of Section 62.0110 of the Municipal Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following language is substituted therefor:

Persons performing work under a permit issued in accordance with this Article shall furnish a performance and materialman's bond or cash deposit in accordance with the following provisions:

Section 2. That Paragraph (a) of Section 62.0111 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The bond may be for a specific project or an annual and continuing bond may be filed with the City covering the costs of several projects. The amount of the bond covering a specific job shall be based on the amount of the estimate submitted by the person doing the work and approved by the City Engineer and in accordance with the schedule in paragraph (b) of this section.

A person may utilize an annual and continuing bond for more than one permit providing the aggregate bonded amount of the permits outstanding do not exceed the total amount of the bond. Annual and continuing bonds shall contain a clause providing the City Engineer with 30 days' notice prior to cancellation.

Section 3.- This ordinance shall take effect and
be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
