AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING SECTIONS 31.0344, 31.0346 AND 31.0349, AND BY AMENDING SECTION 31.0345, ALL RELATING TO LICENSE TAXES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 1, of the San Diego

Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by repealing

Section 31.0344 - License Tax Operating Taxicab; Section 31.0346
License Tax - Operating Sight-Seeing Automobile; and

Section 31.0349 - License Tax - Vehicle for Hire From Railroad

Station.

Section 2. That Chapter III, Article 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 31.0345 - License Tax - Operating Automobile for Hire to read as follows:

SEC. 31.0345 License Tax - Operating Paratransit Vehicles

Every person conducting, managing or carrying on the business of running or operating any paratransit vehicle shall pay a license tax of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per year plus Two Dollars (\$2.00) per employee for the average number employed during the preceding six (6) months, payable annually. In determining the average number of employees during the preceding six (6) months,

the number of employees in the beginning of such period shall be added to the number of employees at the end of such period and the sum thereof divided by two.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


