ORDINANCE NO. (New Series)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 62.0108 RELATING TO THE DETERMINATION AND COLLECTION OF PERMIT FEES FOR PRIVATE CONTRACT WORK IN THE PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF PRIVATE PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 2, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by amending the following section to read as follows:

SEC. 62.0108 FEES UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE DETERMINED AND COLLECTED AS FOLLOWS:

Permit fees or deposits required by this article shall be collected by the City Engineer. A schedule of fees and deposits to cover the costs of processing the various types of work referred to in this article shall be established by the City Manager and filed in the office of the City Clerk. Fixed charges may be established to cover portions of the City costs. Such fixed charges may include but are not limited to the cost for driveway permits, encroachment permits, and update of City records.

Any portion of said deposit not used to cover the actual costs of the City in processing a permit application will be refunded, but no funds will be released until all billings are in, and until final acceptance of the work by the City Engineer. In determining the actual costs incurred by the City in connection with the



processing of final maps and improvements plans, the costs as recorded by the City Auditor and Comptroller shall be prima facie evidence of actual costs of services performed by the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
