AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2,  
DIVISION 8 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE  
BY AMENDING SECTION 62.0801 RELATING TO  
STREET VACATION AND EASEMENT ABANDONMENT FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 2, Division 8  
of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended  
by amending Section 62.0801 to read as follows:

SEC. 62.0801 STREET CLOSING AND EASEMENT  
ABANDONMENT FEES

(a) Purpose and Policy. The City of San Diego  
encounters considerable expense in processing applications  
for street closings and easement abandonments. It is  
the purpose and policy of the Council to establish a  
fee schedule which shall be paid by the applicant upon  
the filing of a request for the processing of an application  
for a street closing or easement abandonment in order to  
reimburse the City for the processing expenses incurred.

(b) The fees shall be established by the City  
Manager in accordance with a schedule of deposits, fees  
and charges filed in the City Clerk's office and included  
in the City's "Ratebook of Fees and Charges." They  
shall be reviewed and revised annually by the City  
Manager to assure that the fees and charges accurately  
represent City's cost.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be  
in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 62.0801 STREET CLOSING AND EASEMENT  
ABANDONMENT FEES

(a) Purpose and Policy. The City of San Diego encounters considerable expense in processing applications for street closings and easement abandonments. It is the purpose and policy of the Council to establish a fee schedule which shall be paid by the applicant upon the filing of a request for the processing of an application for a street closing or easement abandonment in order to reimburse the City for the processing expenses incurred.

(b) The fees shall be as-follows established by the City Manager in accordance with a schedule of deposits, fees and charges filed in the City Clerk's office and included in the City's "Ratebook of Fees and Charges." They shall be reviewed and revised annually by the City Manager to assure that the fees and charges accurately represent City's cost.

~~(1) A fee of \$150.00 for the cost of investigating proposed street closings shall be paid at the time of filing the application for the street closing. This fee is nonrefundable.~~

~~(2) A fee of \$415.00 at the conclusion of the investigation for the costs of all services provided by the City in processing an approved application. Fifty percent of this fee shall be refunded if the City is notified in writing, prior to the ordering of posting of notice and advertising, that the applicant desires to withdraw his application.~~

~~(3) Where the applicant request that a map or plat be prepared by City, an additional fee of \$65.00 shall be paid for each such map or plat. This fee is nonrefundable.~~
