AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2,
DIVISION 2 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0210.1 RELATING TO
PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2 of the San Diego
Municipal Code be amended by amending Section 22.0210.1 to
read as follows:

SEC. 22.0210.1 SAME--ADVERTISING--MINIMUM MONETARY LIMIT


In the construction, reconstruction or repair of
public buildings, streets, utilities and other public
works when the expenditure therefore shall exceed the
sum of \$25,000, the same shall be done by written con-
tract and advertising for bids under the provisions of
Section 94 of the City Charter. The City Manager may,
without additional Council action, award such contracts
to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder provided
that at the time the Council authorizes advertising for
bids the Council also authorizes the necessary expendi-
ture of funds for the contract and authorizes the City
Manager to execute the contract.

As to those public works contracts for which the
expenditure shall not exceed \$25,000, the City Manager
may let the same without advertising for bids if the
Purchasing Agent has secured competitive prices from
contractors interested and the City Manager has taken

those prices under consideration before the contract
is let.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 22.0210.1 SAME--ADVERTISING--MINIMUM MONETARY LIMIT

In the construction, reconstruction or repair of public buildings, streets, utilities and other public works when the expenditure therefore shall exceed the sum of \$25,000, the same shall be done by written contract and advertising for bids under the provisions of Section 94 of the City Charter. The City Manager may, without additional Council action, award such contracts to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder provided that at the time the Council authorizes advertising for bids the Council also authorizes the necessary expenditure of funds for the contract and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract.

As to those public works contracts for which the expenditure shall not exceed \$25,000, the City Manager may let the same without advertising for bids if the Purchasing Agent has secured competitive prices from contractors interested and the City Manager has taken those prices under consideration before the contract is let.

Section 22.0210.1 of the Municipal Code is amended to permit the City Manager to award public works contracts to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder when the expenditure therefore exceeds \$25,000 provided that at the time the Council authorizes advertising for bids the Council also authorizes the necessary expenditure of funds for the contract and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract.
