AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12397 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AMENDING SECTION 2, SUBSECTION 8 THEREOF RELATING TO ALLOCATION OF TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX FUNDS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER THE SUM OF \$205,000 FROM TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX (FUND 223) TO THE CONVENTION AND PERFORMING ARTS CENTER (FUND 254).

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 12397 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Section 2, Subsection 8 thereof relating to allocation of Transient Occupancy Tax Funds to read as follows:

That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$205,000 from Transient Occupancy Tax (Fund 223) to the Convention and Performing Arts Center (Fund 254) to provide sufficient revenues to meet payroll and other operating expenditures.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
