AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12397 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AMENDING SECTION 2, SUBSECTION 8 THEREOF RELATING TO ALLOCATION OF TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX FUNDS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER THE SUM OF \$205,000 FROM TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX (FUND 223) TO THE CONVENTION AND PERFORMING ARTS CENTER (FUND 254).

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 12397 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Section 2, Subsection 8 thereof relating to allocation of Transient Occupancy Tax Funds to read as follows:

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
