AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 24.0105, RELATING TO MEMBERSHIP IN RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, Congress amended the Age Discrimination in Employment Act to cover individuals up to 70 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the City's present Retirement System precludes the membership of an individual beyond the age of 65; and

WHEREAS, the Retirement System's actuary reports that the inclusion of individuals up to the age of 70 will not financially affect the System; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 4, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 24.0105 to read as follows:

SEC. 24.0105 MEMBERSHIP

Except such members of the Police and Fire

Departments who were employed by The City of San Diego

prior to July 1, 1946, and except such employees as

have not heretofore been members of the Retirement

System which is superseded in part hereby, and except

as provided in Sections 24.0105.1 and 24.0105.2,

membership in the Retirement System shall be compulsory

and a condition of employment for all members of the

Classified Service; provided, however, that no officer or employee of The City of San Diego, whether in the Classified or Unclassified Service of the City, shall be required nor permitted to join the Retirement System if said person's employment with the City commences after his or her 70th birthday. Those employees who are not members of the Retirement System which is superseded in part hereby at the date of the taking effect of this article, except policemen and firemen who were employed by the City on or before July 1, 1946, shall be given the option of becoming members, as hereinafter provided.

(Second, third and fourth paragraphs--NO CHANGE.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 24.0105 MEMBERSHIP

Except such members of the Police and Fire Departments who were employed by The City of San Diego prior to July 1, 1946, and except such employees as have not heretofore been members of the Retirement System which is superseded in part hereby, and except as provided in Sections 24.0105.1 and 24.0105.2, membership in the Retirement System shall be compulsory and a condition of employment for all members of the Classified Service; provided, however, that no officer or employee of The City of San Diego, whether in the Classified or Unclassified Service of the City, shall be required nor permitted to join the Retirement System if said person's employment with the City commences after his or her 64th 70th birthday. Those employees who are not members of the Retirement System which is superseded in part hereby at the date of the taking effect of this article, except policemen and firemen who were employed by the City on or before July 1, 1946, shall be given the option of becoming members, as hereinafter provided.
