AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12397 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY AMEND-ING DOCUMENT NO. 764187, AS ADOPTED AND AMENDED THEREIN, BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,418,396 FROM THE GENERAL FUND UNAPPRO-PRIATED FUND BALANCE TO THE GENERAL FUND UNALLOCATED RESERVE (53.37) TO PROVIDE THE ADDITIONAL FUNDS NECESSARY TO GRANT THE SALARY INCREASES TO CITY EMPLOYEES AUTHOR-IZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 12360 (NEW SERIES); AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR AND COMPTROL-LER TO TRANSFER THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO THE BUDGETS OF THE VARIOUS CITY DEPARTMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF GRANTING RETROACTIVE SALARY INCREASES TO CITY EMPLOYEES; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS OF THE EMPLOYEE PENSION TAX FUND TO PROVIDE THE FUNDS NECESSARY FOR THE RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY COSTS INCURRED AS A RESULT OF THE RETROACTIVE SALARY INCREASES.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 12360 (New Series) establishing a schedule of compensation for officers and employees of The City of San Diego for the Fiscal Year 1978-79, on May 30, 1978, which included cost\_of living increases; and

WHEREAS, said salary ordinance was subsequently amended by Emergency Ordinance No. 12384 (New Series) which deleted the salary increases originally provided for, and Ordinance No. 12422 (New Series) which corrected an omission in the Emergency Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the ordinances amending the salary ordinance were adopted to qualify the City for State relief funds

granted pursuant to Senate Bill 154 to meet the fiscal emergency faced by the City due to the passage of Proposition 13; and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 1979, the California Supreme

Court rendered a decision entitled Sonoma County Organization

of Public Employees, et al. v. County of Sonoma, et al.; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court in Sonoma declared it to be unconstitutional for the State of California to require a municipality to withhold pay increases to qualify for State relief funds and that such a requirement impaired existing contracts and was violative of the home rule provisions of the California Constitution: and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court in Sonoma further found that through the payment of relief funds, any emergency faced by municipalities through the passage of Proposition 13 was largely alleviated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 12593
(New Series) on February 20, 1979, rescinding Emergency
Ordinance Nos. 12384 (New Series) and 12422 (New Series)
thereby reinstating Ordinance No. 12360 (New Series), which
action required the budgets of the City departments to be
increased by the cost of living increases; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 12397 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET

FOR FISCAL YEAR 1978-79 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document No. 764187, as adopted and amended therein, by appropriating the sum of \$1,418,396 from the General Fund Unappropriated Fund Balance to the General Fund Unallocated Reserve (53.37) to provide the additional funds necessary to grant the salary increases to City employees authorized by Ordinance No. 12360 (New Series).

Section 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the funds . necessary to the budgets of the various City departments for the purpose of granting retroactive salary increases to City employees.

Section 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to increase appropriations of the Employee Pension Tax Fund to provide the funds necessary for the Retirement and Social Security costs incurred as a result of the retroactive salary increases.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its adoption.
