AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING
SECTION 26.20 ESTABLISHING A LA JOLLA PARKING
AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA ADVISORY BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6 of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by adding Section
26.20 to read as follows:

SEC. 26.20 LA JOLLA PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT
AREA ADVISORY BOARD

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to
establish a policy advisory board on matters relating to
the general promotion of retail trade activities in the
La Jolla Parking and Business Improvement area and public
parking for vehicles, and the promotion of various modes
of transportation, such as walking, bicycling and public
transit within the area.

B. CREATION AND APPOINTMENTS

There is hereby created a La Jolla Parking and
Business Improvement Area Advisory Board consisting of
seven (7) members who shall serve without compensation.
The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed
by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year
terms and each member shall serve until his/her successor
is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be

appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than four (4) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date shall be March 1. During March of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation the Board shall, on or after April 15, select from among their members a Chairperson.

C. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Board may adopt such rules, regulations and organizational structure for the conduct of its business as it may deem necessary.

D. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

The Board shall:

(1) Advise the City Council through the City Manager on public policy matters relating to the general promotion of retail trade and public parking for vehicles and the promotion of various modes of transportation within the area.

(2) Prepare an annual budget for the expenditure of funds as are collected by the district.

(3) Hear appeals regarding exemptions from the assessment of profit or nonprofit businesses which do not pay an ordinary business license tax.

(4) Advise on a continuing basis and make recommendations regarding the La Jolla Parking and Business Improvement Area.

B. CREATION AND APPOINTMENTS

There is hereby created a La Jolla Parking and Business Improvement Area Advisory Board consisting of seven (7) members who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his/her successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than four (4) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date shall be March 1. During March of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation the Board shall, on or after April 15, select from among their members a Chairperson.

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The Board may adopt such rules, regulations and organizational structure for the conduct of its business as it may deem necessary.

D. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

The Board shall:

- (1) Advise the City Council through the City Manager on public policy matters relating to the general promotion of retail trade and public parking for vehicles and the promotion of various modes of transportation within the area.
- (2) Prepare an annual budget for the expenditure of funds as are collected by the district.
- (3) Hear appeals regarding exemptions from the assessment of profit or nonprofit businesses which do not pay an ordinary business license tax.
- (4) Advise on a continuing basis and make recommendations regarding the La Jolla Parking and Business Improvement Area.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
