WHEREAS, the City Council has approved and adopted the Southeast San Diego Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, various areas within the Community Plan are shown for residential uses which areas are presently zoned for commercial uses; and

WHEREAS, those areas shown for residential purposes are developed with predominately residential uses; and

whereas, the development of commercial uses on those areas shown for residential uses would frustrate the purpose of the Plan, be detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare and contribute to the deterioration of the neighborhoods by the introduction of incompatible commercial uses into areas of residential development; and

WHEREAS, the initiation of redevelopment projects within the Southeast San Diego Community Plan Area has caused and will continue to cause the relocation of commercial land uses from the redevelopment areas to those areas of the community which are presently zoned for commercial purposes; and

WHEREAS, such relocation to areas of the community which the Community Plan designates for residential use would not be in the public interest and the imminence of such relocation constitutes an emergency requiring that an ordinance be immediately introduced and adopted to protect

the public health, safety and welfare and protect the integrity of the residential community and Community Plan for future development; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That all that real property within The City of San Diego, presently designated as commercial and industrial zones and depicted on Map No. <u>C-653</u>, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. <u>'766843</u>, is hereby placed in the R2A Zone and all the provisions of Municipal Code Section 101.0410 shall hence forth apply thereto for the period during which this ordinance is applicable thereto.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon its introduction and adoption. This ordinance shall be of no further force or effect 90 days from the date of its adoption.
