AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 9, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 59.0101 AND 59.0102 AND BY ADDING SECTIONS 59.0104 AND 59.0105, ALL RELATING TO THE SAN DIEGO STADIUM AND BALBOA STADIUM.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 9, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by amending Sections 59.0101 and 59.0102 to read as follows:

SEC. 59.0101 PURPOSE AND INTENT

This Division of Article 9 shall contain ordinances regarding the use of San Diego Stadium,
San Diego Stadium Parking Facility and Balboa Stadium which are enacted for the purpose and intent of protecting the public health, welfare and safety of the spectators and participants at events held therein.
SEC. 59.0102 DEFINITIONS

whenever in this Division the words or phrases in this section defined are used, they shall have the respective meanings assigned to them as follows:

(a) "Balboa Stadium" shall mean that certain municipally-owned structure located on "A" Street in the City of San Diego, the peripheral boundaries of which are the gates for entrance and exit and the walls surrounding the structure.

- (b) "San Diego Stadium" shall mean that certain multipurpose sports structure located in Mission Valley in the City of San Diego, the peripheral boundaries of which are the gates for access and egress and the walls surrounding the outer perimeter buildings.
- (c) "San Diego Stadium Parking Facility" shall mean all parking areas, entrances and exits continuous from street grade and all passenger waiting areas at the San Diego Stadium.
- (d) "Parking Space" shall mean any area marked with lines designating a parking space at the San Diego Stadium Parking Facility except those parking spaces designated and numbered as "Tailgate Parking Spaces." Parking spaces may be marked for small cars or for standard size cars.

 Parking space for vehicles exceeding twenty feet (20°) in length shall mean two spaces marked for standard size cars.
- (e) "Tailgate Parking Spaces" shall mean reserved and numbered spaces measuring 40 feet in length for parking vehicles located in a designated tailgate parking area.
- Section 2. That Chapter V, Article 9, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by adding Sections 59.0104 and 59.0105 to read as follows:

SEC. 59.0104 STADIUM PARKING

(a) No person shall park or stand any vehicle in more than one parking space or, where applicable, in more than one Tailgate Parking Space. If the vehicle exceeds twenty feet (20') in length, the driver thereof shall only park

said vehicle in parking spaces for standard size vehicles and pay for the additional space and display evidence of such payment unless parked in a Tailgate Parking Space.

- (b) No person shall utilize in any manner more than the parking space or Tailgate Parking Space that his vehicle is entitled to occupy under the provisions of paragraph (a) of this Section and paragraphs (d) and (e) of Section 59.0102.
- (c) No person shall interfere in any manner with the use of an adjacent parking space.

SEC. 59.0105 TOWING

Vehicles parked in violation of Section 59.0104 shall be towed at owners' expense to a place designated by the City Manager.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
