AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND IN THE SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT, ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 1979.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, September 18, 1979, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

MAYOR	five-year term
COUNCILMEMBER - District No. 2	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER - District No. 4	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER - District No. 6	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER - District No. 8	four-year term

Section 2. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the San Diego Unified School District on Tuesday, September 18, 1979, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION - District A	four-year term
MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION - District D	four-year term
MEMBER BOARD OF EDUCATION - District E	four-year term

Section 3. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the San Diego Community College District on Tuesday, September 18, 1979, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

MEMBER OF GOVERNING BOARD OF TRUSTEES - District B	four-year term
MEMBER OF GOVERNING BOARD OF TRUSTEES - District D	four-year term

Section 4. For the purpose of said elections, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said elections.

Section 6. That the polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 18, 1979.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 8. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Inspectors	\$35.00	
Judges	\$30.00	
Clerks	\$30.00	
Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00	
For return of each ballot bag	\$ 2.00	- each to two precinct board members transporting election packages to collection centers, one-way only

Section 9. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 10." Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
