ORDINANCE NO. O- 15006
(New Series)AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATES AND LEVYING
TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80.

WHEREAS, the Jarvis-Gann Initiative (herein called Proposition 13) amending the California Constitution to limit property taxes was placed before the electorate on June 6, 1978; and

WHEREAS, said Proposition 13 was passed by the voters on that election day and became effective on July 1, 1978; and

WHEREAS, heretofore the Charter of The City of San Diego has required the City Council to adopt, not later than the last day in August of each year, an annual tax levying ordinance; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the passage of Proposition 13 and the adoption of state legislation (1978 Senate Bill Nos. 154 and 2212 and 1979 Assembly Bill No. 8), the Charter requirements concerning the annual tax levy have been modified and superseded; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Proposition 13 and the state legislation, the annual tax levy allowed by the City is limited to certain exceptions provided for in Proposition 13 and Section 2237 of the Revenue and Taxation Code; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 13 and Section 2237 of the Revenue and Taxation Code require the County of San Diego to levy the annual ad valorem property tax and distribute it to the districts within the County; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 75 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, Proposition 13 and the state legislation adopted pursuant thereto, there is hereby fixed a rate of taxation of eight cents and eight mills (\$0.088) on each one hundred dollars' valuation of taxable property within the City of San Diego, as shown on the assessment roll of the County of San Diego for the fiscal year 1979-80, and that the rate is hereby levied on all taxable property, both real and personal, in the City of San Diego. Included herein is the amount requested to be levied by Section 77a of said Charter.

Section 2. An allowance of four percent (4%) for anticipated delinquencies in tax payments upon real property and improvements thereon and personal property secured, other than properties of public utilities, is hereby established.

Section 3. The rate is computed as follows:

Section 4. Pursuant to the provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code, Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 12, Section 61.1201, and Resolution No. 201037 of the Council of The City of San Diego, adopted October 15, 1970, there is hereby fixed a rate of taxation of forty-four cents and no mills (\$.440) on each one hundred dollars' land valuation of taxable property designated as Zone A within the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District and a rate of taxation of eight cents and eight mills (\$.088) on each one hundred dollars' land valuation of taxable property designated as Zone B within the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District, and these rates are hereby levied on all taxable land in the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District as shown on the assessment roll of the County of San Diego for the fiscal year 1979-80.

Section 5. An allowance of six percent (6%) for anticipated delinquencies in tax payment upon real property (land) in the Penasquitos Sewer Improvement District is hereby established.

Section 6. The rates have been computed as follows:
