AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 62.0103 BY ADDING SUBSECTIONS (d)
AND (e), RELATING TO GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR
WORK IN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND LAND DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 2, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending
Section 62.0103 by adding subsections (d) and (e), to read
as follows:

SEC. 62.0103 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR WORK IN PUBLIC
RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND LAND DEVELOPMENT

Subsections (a), (b) and (c) remain the same.


(d) Any person or entity performing work in any
public street, alley, or sidewalk shall provide a
bond as described in Section 62.0110 of this Code and
shall comply with the requirements of said section.

(e) Any person or entity performing work as herein-
above described shall expeditiously complete such work
and shall restore the street surface to its original
grade and in compliance with the City's standards and
specifications within five (5) working days after com-
pletion of the portland cement concrete subcap construction
in the case of four-lane or greater major streets and

within ten (10) working days for other streets. The City Engineer may, under unusual circumstances, grant extensions where absolutely warranted. In all other cases, the City Engineer shall inform the permittee and bonding company of any failure to meet the above requirements and if the permittee or bonding company does not expeditiously cause the completion of the repair work, the City Engineer shall cause the work to be completed by City forces and shall proceed against the permittee and bonding company to collect all costs incurred by City in completing such work. All costs shall be based on premium overtime rates with overhead charges being applied to labor and materials.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

(e) Any person or entity performing work as herein above described shall expeditiously complete such work and shall restore the street surface to its original grade and in compliance with the City's standards and specifications within five (5) working days after completion of the portland cement concrete subcap construction in the case of four-lane or greater major streets and within ten (10) working days for other streets. The City Engineer may, under unusual circumstances, grant extensions where absolutely warranted. In all other cases, the City Engineer shall inform the permittee and bonding company of any failure to meet the above requirements and if the permittee or bonding company does not expeditiously cause the completion of the repair work, the City Engineer shall cause the work to be completed by City forces and shall proceed against the permittee and bonding company to collect all costs incurred by City in completing such work. All costs shall be based on premium overtime rates with overhead charges being applied to labor and materials.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
