BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 6, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending Section
56.53(d) to read as follows:

SEC. 56.53 NUDITY ON PUBLIC LANDS


a., b. and c. - No change.

d. The provisions of this section shall not
apply to live theatrical performances performed in
a theater, concert hall, or other similar establish-
ment located on public land. As used in this section,
theater, concert hall or similar establishment means
a building, playhouse, room, hall or other enclosed
place not open to public view from any public right
of way but having a stage upon which movable scenery
is located and theatrical, vaudeville or similar per-
formances are given and seats so arranged that a body of
spectators can have an unobstructed view of the stage and
whose primary function is to give such performances.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
