AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE PROPOSED TRANSFER OF CONTROL OF THE MISSION CABLE TV, INC. FRANCHISE FOR THE NONEXCLUSIVE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE TO LAY AND USE LINES, WIRES, COAXIAL CABLE AND APPURTENANCES FOR TRANSMITTING, DISTRIBUTING AND SUPPLYING RADIO AND TELEVISION ANTENNA SERVICE ALONG, ACROSS AND UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS, WAYS, ALLEYS AND PLACES WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS OF SAN DIEGO AS THE RESULT OF A MERGER OF COX BROADCASTING CORPORATION AND GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has by Ordinance No. 12543 (N.S.) granted the nonexclusive right, privilege and franchise to lay and use lines, wires, coaxial cable and appurtenances for transmitting, distributing and supplying radio and television antenna service along, across and upon the public streets, ways, alleys and places within certain areas of San Diego, as more particularly set forth in said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Mission Cable TV, Inc. has by a letter dated August 28, 1979, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 15085, requested The City of San Diego to approve the proposed transfer of control pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. 12543 (N.S.) of the Mission Cable TV, Inc. franchise in San Diego as a result of a corporate merger of Cox Broadcasting Corporation and General Electric Company, all as more particularly set forth in said letter;  
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Section 1. That The City of San Diego does by this ordinance approve the proposed transfer of control pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. 12543 (N.S.) of the Mission Cable franchise in San Diego as a result of a corporate merger of Cox Broadcasting Corporation and General Electric Company, as more particularly set forth in the letter documented as No. 00-15085 and subject to all the terms and conditions contained in said Ordinance No. 12543 (N.S.).

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
