to lay and use lines, wires, coaxial cable and appurtenances
for transmitting, distributing and supplying radio and television antenna service along, across and upon the public streets,

WHEREAS, Mission Cable TV, Inc. has by a letter dated August 28, 1979, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. Oo-15085, requested The City of San Diego to approve the proposed transfer of control pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. 12543 (N.S.) of the Mission Cable TV, Inc. franchise in San Diego as a result of a corporate merger of Cox Broadcasting Corporation and General Electric Company, all as more particularly set forth in said letter; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:
