

RESOLUTION NO. 222588

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 1978, ON TWO PROPOSITIONS RELATING TO THE SALE OR CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN PUEBLO LANDS AND TWO PROPOSITIONS AMENDING THE CITY CHARTER.

WHEREAS, this Council by Ordinance No. 12414 (New Series) adopted August 14, 1978, called a special municipal election to be held in the City on November 7, 1978; and

WHEREAS, this special municipal election was duly consolidated with the statewide general election held upon the same date; and

WHEREAS, the special municipal election was held on November 7, 1978, for the purpose of proposing and submitting to the qualified electors of the City two propositions relating to the sale or conveyance of certain Pueblo lands and two propositions amending the City Charter, as follows:

PROPOSITION H:

CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENT.  
AMENDS SECTION 18 OF THE CHARTER OF THE  
CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

Shall the Charter be amended to permit the publication of the title, number and digest of an ordinance or resolution of general interest rather than the full text thereof?

PROPOSITION J:

CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENT.  
AMENDS SECTION 71 OF THE CHARTER OF THE  
CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

Shall the Charter be amended to  
limit the amount of money that may be  
set aside for the general operations  
of the City?

PROPOSITION K:

RATIFICATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 12399  
(NEW SERIES).

Shall Ordinance No. 12399 (New Series)  
entitled, "An Ordinance Authorizing the  
Sale or Conveyance of the Remaining  
Portions of Pueblo Lots 1317, 1318 and  
1351 of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego,  
Upon Such Terms and Conditions as may  
be deemed by the City Council to be in  
the Best Interest of the People of the  
City of San Diego," adopted by the  
Council of The City of San Diego be  
ratified?

PROPOSITION L:

RATIFICATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 12400  
(NEW SERIES).

Shall Ordinance No. 12400 (New Series)  
entitled, "An Ordinance Authorizing the  
Sale or Conveyance of the Remaining  
Portions of Pueblo Lots 1353 and 1355  
of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, Upon  
Such Terms and Conditions as may be  
deemed by the City Council to be in the  
Best Interests of the People of the City  
of San Diego," adopted by the Council of  
The City of San Diego be ratified?

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassing the returns of the special municipal election, including absentee votes cast, as certified to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the special municipal election has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

1. The total number of votes cast in the City, including absentee votes, is 273,792.

2. The number of votes, including absentee votes, cast for and against each of the four propositions lettered H, J, K and L and the total number of votes cast upon each proposition, including absentee votes, are as follows:

PROPOSITION H:

Propositions K and L did not receive the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters voting on said propositions and are hereby declared to have failed.

4. The number of votes cast, including absentee votes, is recorded in the Election Returns Book, which book is a part of the records of this Council.

5. The City Clerk shall make public the results of the canvass of the special municipal election by publication of a copy of this resolution.
