BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA) consents to fund the above project from funds made available through the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act, The City of San Diego agrees to accept the grant and designates the City Manager to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the contract for the grant for law enforcement purposes, including any extensions or amendments thereof, that do not require any additional appropriation of cash match.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego agrees to provide the required matching funds to said project (including any extension or amendments thereof) under the Safe Streets Act and the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration and that cash will be appropriated as required thereby.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized without further Council action to go to bid (when necessary) and to execute contracts for the consultant services, leases, purchases, and all other related contracts and agreements specified in the grant contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that \$33,333 of City funds shall be appropriated in the City's Fiscal Year 1980 Budget for the purpose of the required cash match specified in the grant contract.
