WHEREAS, OFFICER SAMUEL K. CATER of the San Diego Police Department and another officer were administering first aid to two gunshot victims in front of the school when the sniper opened fire at them; and

WHEREAS, OFFICER CATER and the second officer continued to provide first aid under gunfire until the victims were taken to the hospital; NOW, THEREFORE,
