WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 222247 dated November 20, 1978, the Purchasing Agent was authorized to purchase on the open market Bond and Mimeograph Paper as may be required for a period not to exceed six (6) months beginning November 15, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the paper strike which has affected all major mills west of the Mississippi River since July 22, 1978, is still causing a paper shortage; and

WHEREAS, some paper mills are currently in the process of negotiating contracts; and

WHEREAS, it will take approximately 120 days after all the paper mills are operating before there will be an appreciable increase in the supply of paper, at which time the City should be able to receive firm bids under the competitive bidding process; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that Resolution No. 222247 dated November 20, 1978, is modified to authorize the Purchasing Agent to purchase on the open market Bond and Mimeograph Paper as may be required for a period not to exceed ten (10) months beginning November 15, 1978.
