EXHIBIT A

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FINDINGS FOR RIDGE VISTA ESTATES

The following findings are recommended relative to the conclusions of the final environmental impact report (EIR) for the proposed Ridge Vista Estates (EQD No. 78-11-34). These findings have been prepared pursuant to Sections 15089 and 15089 of the California Administrative Code and pursuant to Section 21081 of the California Public Resources Code.

FINDINGS

A. The City Council, having reviewed and considered the information contained in the final, revised EIR for the proposed Ridge Vista Estates (EQD No. 78-11-34), finds that changes or alterations are being required in, or have been incorporated into, the project which mitigate or avoid the significant environmental effects thereof, as identified in the final EIR. Specifically:

1. Biology

Impact. "The proposed developed would remove 60 percent of the native vegetation including portions of three regionally significant plant species . . ."

Findings. The project design substantially mitigates the impact on biological resources through:

- a. Retention of approximately four acres of natural slopes at the north of the property facing Miramar Reservoir, and
- b. Retention of approximately 1-3/4 acres of natural slopes at the southwest corner of the property, including a stand of Eucalyptus trees, through an open space easement.

2. Hydrology

Impact. A potential exists for drainage into the Miramar Reservoir.

Finding. The site design has been specifically engineered to direct runoff from developed portions of the site southward, away from the reservoir watershed.
