(R. 79-1783)

WHEREAS, the City/County Regional Solid Waste Management Plan 1976-2000 cites the need for cooperative planning and joint supportive decisions to provide solid waste land disposal facilities in the region of San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, a number of sanitary landfills operated by the County of San Diego have been closed without replacement; and

WHEREAS, lack of these needed public faiclities has caused the City of San Diego to accommodate additional waste from outside the City thereby diminishing scarce landfill space in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has for the past six years attempted to provide replacement sanitary landfills within the City to protect the public health; and

WHEREAS, local government has been subjected to a number of mandates, regulations and financial burdens imposed by other levels of government; and

WHEREAS, lack of a close-in disposal facility will result in \$7.4 million in unnecessary additional expenditures, additional traffic and air pollution because of the added haul distance; and

WHEREAS, the City has proposed a well designed, environmentally sound, close-in solid waste disposal facility to serve the disposal needs of the urban core of metropolitan San Diego,

MICROFILMED

namely, the North Chollas Sanitary Landfill, and experts in all fields of solid waste management, public health and environmental issues have found it to meet or exceed all present State standards; and

WHEREAS, City staff, County staff and State agencies have reviewed numerous alternatives to the North Chollas Sanitary Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego on August 10, 1978, determined that "in view of current budget restraints, the County is unable to contribute directly to the cost of disposal of the City of San Diego's solid waste"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes this to be the only viable economic and environmentally sound short term disposal alternative available; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council of said City strongly urges the Board of Supervisors to make the appropriate findings required by Government Code Section 66784.1 to allow the City to proceed with the development of this urgently needed solid waste disposal facility.
